



## ICS 192 Course Enrollment Application

In order to be eligible to enroll in ICS 192, students:

- A) Must be in good academic standing and not on probation
- B) May not be pursuing employment (paid or unpaid) elsewhere
- C) Enroll no later than Friday of Week 2 of the quarter (Friday of Week 1 for Summer Session)
- D) Must agree to submit a final report and supporting paperwork by end of Week 8 of the quarter
- E) May not enroll in ICS 192 more than 4 times while enrolled at UCI.

For International Students - Prior to internship start date, students must:

- A) Review the CPT requirements on the International Center website.
- B) Meet with an ICS Academic Counselor and provide them with:
  - 1) An academic plan showing progress toward degree completion
  - 2) A job offer letter that includes employment start and end date (**dates must coincide with start/end date of the academic quarter**), job description, and company logo/letterhead
